The February 2007 meeting of Skystreakers R/C was called to order at 7:00 pm by President, Nelson Frost, with 22 members present.

The Treasurers report was given by Dave Edwards and was accepted as read.

OLD BUSINESS

NEW BUSINESS

Dates for upcoming events for the year were requested by Peter Flannagan. Father's Day, June 17th for the annual High Wing Fun Fly, and August 25 and 26 for the Scale Shootout, which will be hosted by Peter and Bill Lairsey this year. The above dates were accepted for both events.

Dave Martin had a list of events for the year, but decided to wait until the IMAC contest date was scheduled to see what dates would be available. We usually only have one field closing event per month, so the field is open for regular flying at least 3 weekends per month.

Much of the meeting involved discussion of the new Paid Instructor Program to be implemented this year. Dave Martin passed out handouts outlining the parameters, requirements, and suggestions for initiating the new program. This new program is being proposed to assure there will be adequate instructors at the field on trainer night to accommodate new pilots/members. To qualify for payment in the form of free club membership for the year, each instructor would have to attend a specific number of trainer nights.

Discussion of the specifics of : how many instructors, changing the number of pilot stations, pilot time for each student, etc., were discussed. President Nelson, after much member discussion, requested that Dave put the requirements as agreed to in written form to present at the next meeting for the possibility that they may be written into the club by-laws.

Ray Labonte requested that the Intro Pilot Program be continued. There had been discussion about dropping it. It was decided to keep the program with Ray and Mac as Intro Pilots.
